Presentation Title: Discovering the Power of Positive Psychology and Paradigm Shifts in Couples Therapy

Abstract: The Times are a Changin'!! Our psychology and our culture are abundant with examples of a growing collaborative mindset and the power of focusing on solutions and strengths over individualism and problems.

In this workshop participants will be exposed to techniques drawn from several approaches (Positive Psychology, Couple Power therapy, Nurtured Heart Approach, Family systems, Gottman) and how to implement them in clinical practice. The goal is to learn to facilitate and Co-create solutions and more importantly ways of thinking that move individuals toward a collaborative/collective way of thinking where Strengths, Trust, Fondness, Admiration, "Couple", Love and Success are consciously built, and being right, correct, in control and winning are diminished. The workshop will be full of practical, experiential tools and exercises designed to provide the attendee a personal understanding of the impact of the techniques and create a paradigm shift to guide your practice and your life!

Presenter: **Joseph Clem, MA, LMFT** is a Licensed Marriage and Family Therapist, Certified Nurtured Heart Advanced Trainer/Therapist, and QMRP Behavior Specialist. He is the founder of The Center for Marriage and Family in Williamsville, NY, where he is in private practice serving individuals, couples and families. Joe oversees the behavioral health department at Southeast Works in Depew, NY serving over 350 adults with developmental disabilities. He also sees or has seen clients for New Directions and Gateway Longview in the Wrap-a-round model, and Baker Victory's foster care service Bridges to Health (B2H). He holds a master's degree in clinical psychology from Antioch University and is currently earning his BCBA (Board Certified Behavioral Analyst) certificate.
