

# ALANA ACHIEVEMENT AWARD FOR GRADUATING SENIORS

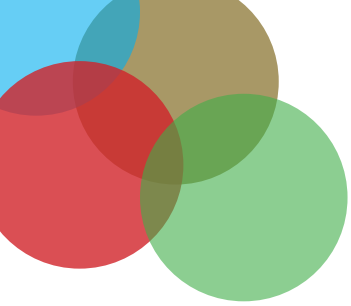
