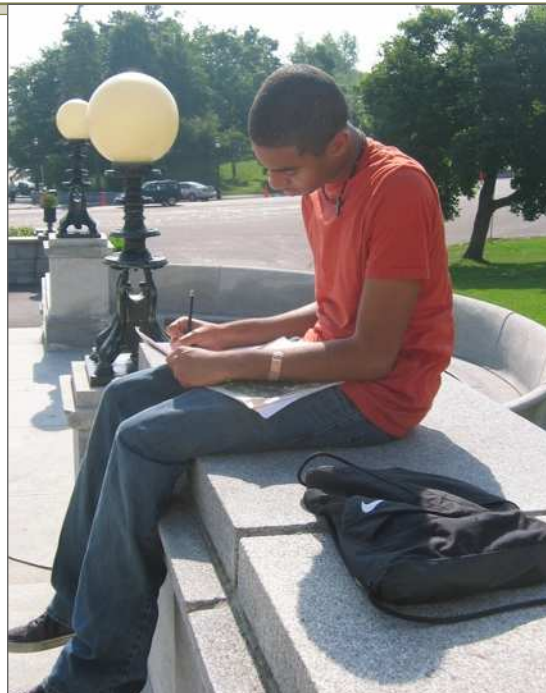

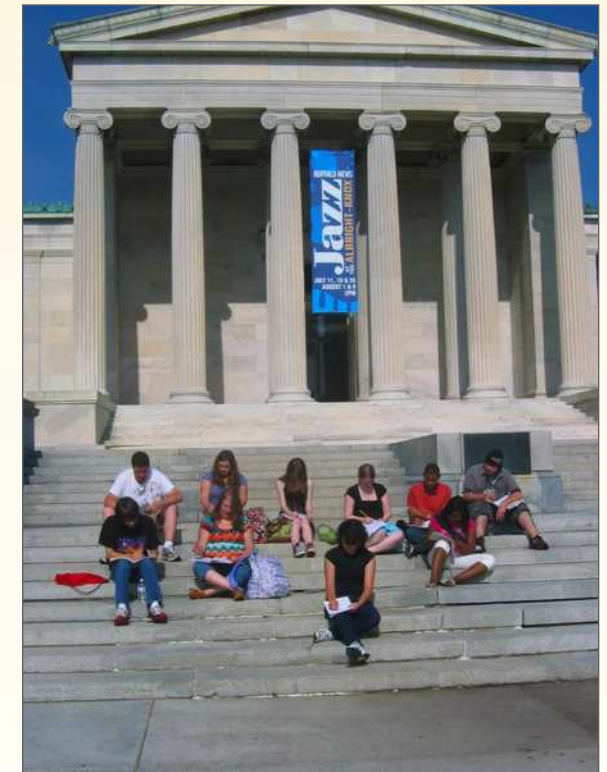

In the Teen Writing Workshop, the focus is on creative writing. A workshop for motivated writers, students spend time each day with writing groups. There, they share their writing and grow from the guidance of their peers and mentor teachers.

Participants benefit from a number of other activities, including visits from local authors, open mic sessions each week, and creating a print and audio anthology to publish their work.

## YOUNG WRITERS' CAMP

GRADES 3-7

Each year, the Young Writers' Camp is organized around a theme. In 2013, the summer's theme is *exploring nature*. Like the Teen Writing Workshop, the focus of the camp is to develop its participants' creative writing skills.

During the two weeks of camp, campers will work together both in small groups and individually to develop interesting and thoughtful pieces of writing. They will write poetry, mini-dramas, stories, songs, and more. In addition, the Young Writers always make videos during camp. The videos will be shown at the final reception.

This year, our field trip will be to the Tiff Nature Preserve (<http://www.sciencebuff.org/tiff-nature-preserve/>) on Thursday, July 11.

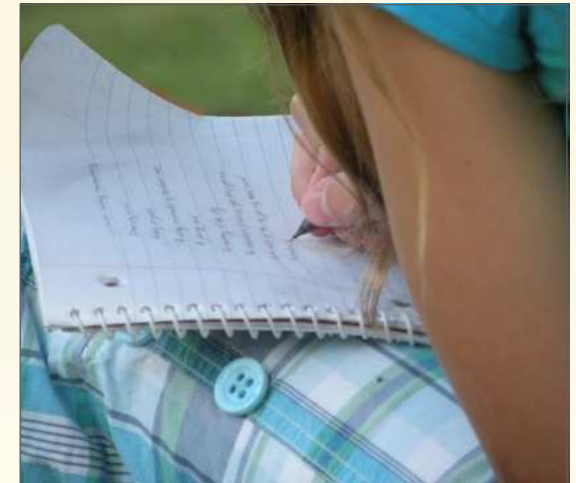


**"THIS PROGRAM IS SUCH A GIFT"**

*The Workshops are an opportunity for students to develop and expand their writing skills, focusing on creative writing.*

Cost: \$225 per student (\$250 if you register after July 1, 2013)
